Deposit: Deposit to hold a puppy, in planning, in utero or once born is \$400. The amount is non-refundable unless the following arises:

- 1) The dam does not produce a litter and the buyer does not want to wait until the next available litter.
- 2) The requested gender of puppy is not available and the buyer does not want to wait until the next litter.
- 3) During the health exam at the breeders veterinarian, a problem is reported and the buyer no longer wants the puppy, in which case the buyer can apply their deposit toward a different puppy, if available. If not available, a cash refund or credit toward the next litter will be offered.
- 4) Gallant Cotons reserves the right to refund any amount, any time, at their discretion.

Under these circumstances, the buyer will receive their deposit back within a reasonable time following the announcement to buyer.

No deposit will be refunded due to "change of heart", medical issues, moving homes, new baby, divorce/marriage, etc. You can choose to refuse delivery of the puppy (up until the puppy leaves Gallant Farm for its new home) and instead apply the deposit later toward another puppy, from a future litter.

Microchip: Gallant Farm has provided your new puppy with a microchip for its future safety. Gallant Cotons will register the puppy's information in a national database, free of charge, with the information you provide to us. If your information (address/phone etc) changes, you will be responsible for having it updated as soon as possible for the safety of your dog. Gallant Cotons will remain as a "secondary rescue contact" in the National Database, for the lifetime of the dog.

Registration of your puppy: At the time of pickup of your new puppy, you may view parental registrations. All puppies are sold on a spay/neuter contract. The buyer agrees to have the puppy spayed or neutered within 12 months of age. Any available registrations (AKC, UKC, etc) will be sent if requested when the puppy is spay/neutered, and documentation of proof is sent to Gallant Farm.

Health Inspection by Veterinarian:

Your Gallant Coton will be guaranteed to be in good health as described below when he or she is delivered to you. The puppy will be fully vet-checked, he or she will have exams for eyes, ears, bite/teeth, nose, skin, joints, feet, heart, lungs, abdomen and a check for external parasites. If the exams don't have perfect results, you will be notified of any condition before finalizing the sale by leaving the property with the puppy. Your puppy will be properly vaccinated, and will have been on a deworming program beginning at 2 weeks of age. We have cared for this puppy like it was one of our own (because he/she is!). You will also receive record of vaccinations and de-wormings done, so that you may present to your veterinarian.

Unable to be covered by seller, are common puppy ailments such as: parasites, undescended testicles, under/overbites, dental issues (except cleft palate), allergies, ear mites, coccidia, giardia, hypoglycemia and respiratory infection. Parvo and distemper cannot be covered after 48 hours from departure time from Gallant Farm. Fair coverage to be determined by Gallant Farms. No claim will ever exceed the purchase price of the puppy.

Your new Coton de Tulear puppy purchased from Gallant Farm comes with a "healthy puppy" guarantee!

Conditions of guarantee: Buyer must provide adequate care for the dog, feed a premium quality pet food such as NutriSource, and make every attempt to keep the dogs weight at a normal, healthy level. The buyer must provide necessary vet care & preventative care, including keeping the teeth clean (infections in the mouth can lead to Mitral Valve Disease). Failure to comply with this standard level of care will void all guarantees and no registration papers will be given. **The buyer must keep dog vaccinated properly for Rabies.**

***** The buyer must spay or neuter their Gallant Coton by 12 months of age unless other arrangements are agreed to in writing. You are purchasing this puppy with NO BREEDING RIGHTS** unless you have a separate breeding rights contract signed by me AND notarized. We take this very seriously. You may be responsible for financial damages by Gallant Cotons for every litter produced if your Gallant Coton is found to have produced a litter(s) of puppies. ***

The buyer will be responsible for all daily health care for their Gallant Coton, including immunizations, examinations recommended after purchase, as well as providing necessary medications and follow-up treatment from veterinarian visits. The buyer is responsible for any and all expenses accumulated from the day they take possession of their puppy. Gallant Farm can't be responsible for any contagious illnesses because they

could have been contracted after the dog has left our facility (parvo, influenza, pneumonia, etc). We ask that you do your best to keep your Coton de Tulear at a weight reasonable for their stature to extend their life.

If your Gallant Coton is discovered to have a genetic disorder before the age of 12 months (heart, lungs, liver, cancer, hip dysplasia, eyes) the buyer will provide the seller with a letter from the attending veterinarian (DVM) on office letterhead which includes documentation of diagnosis, diagnostic test results, breed of dog, birthdate, microchip number, and signature of verification. This genetic disorder must be verified by a licensed veterinarian and documentation presented during the puppy's first year. Dental issues cannot be covered except in the case of cleft palate.

Should your veterinarian determine the puppy has a covered genetic condition, the buyer agrees to immediately return the puppy to Gallant Farm, at the buyer's' expense, so that the puppy can be cared for by our veterinarian, at our expense. Within a reasonable time, we will issue a refund check for up to the full amount of the puppy. Flight expense, microchip registration fees, shipping prep fees, veterinarian fees, etc will not be included in the refund.

Should you choose to keep the puppy, and treat any medical illness found, the buyer agrees not to hold the seller financially liable for veterinary expenses above and beyond the purchase price of the puppy. Treatment can be expensive depending upon the region of the country, but cost of veterinary services reimbursed are based upon our vet prices in North Branch, MN and South Shores Forest Lake, MN. Gallant Farm cannot be responsible for any amount higher than the cost of the puppy including time lost from work, hardship to family, loss of sleep, etc.

The cost of food, OTC medications, overnight kenneling or other related costs beyond the veterinary fees cannot be reimbursed. Payment will be made to the buyer within a reasonable time once required documentation is received.

In the very sad event of the pets death within the first 7 days, the buyer agrees to have an autopsy completed. If the autopsy states specifically that the death was the result of a genetic illness or an illness which was contracted while in the care of Gallant Farm, the price of the puppy and the autopsy fee (not to exceed \$200) will be refunded. Within 10 days of receipt of invoice, we will issue a refund check in the amount of the purchase price of the puppy, and the autopsy fee. Please remember that flight expense, microchip registration, shipping prep fees, vet fees, etc . will not be included in this refund. Only the purchase price of the puppy (the amount listed on top of this contract), and the actual autopsy fee (not to exceed \$200) can be refunded. Of course, accidental death, or lack of proper care would not be covered in the guarantee and no reimbursement would be made.

While we do our best to get you the puppy you want, Gallant Farms does not guarantee size, color, trainability, temperament, or any other things as controlled by nature. If at any time during your puppy's life you decide you can no longer keep your puppy, we ask that you return the dog to us, if feasible. We can help in re-homing when necessary. No monetary compensation can be given in re-homing situations, but finding a good home is always our top priority, or we will keep the dog ourselves.

If, for any reason any litigation of this transaction occurs, they shall be held within the County of Chisago, in the State of Minnesota. If any part of this guarantee should be in violation of a law, that section of the contract shall become null and void.

This guarantee is non-transferable should the buyer choose to re-home their Gallant Coton.

This guarantee is valid for one year from the puppy's date of birth. Buyer takes 100% responsibility for future costs and care after puppy turns one year of age.

Buyer: By purchasing a puppy from Gallant Cotons, I am agreeing to this contract whether or not the contract is signed by either party. **ALL GALLANT COTON PUPPY SALES ARE SUBJECT TO THE TERMS OF THIS CONTRACT WHETHER OR NOT A CONTRACT IS SIGNED.**

I agree to spay/neuter my puppy before the age of 9-12 months (usually 6 months) at which time I can present the proof of neuter to Gallant Cotons so that the AKC/UKC registration papers can be released to me.

I agree not to breed my Gallant Coton de Tulear under any circumstance unless I, the buyer(s), have a separate breeding authorization signed and notarized by Tracy Welsch and myself, the buyer.
